In a well-conducted trial designed to see whether cranberry powder sachets were 'as good as' preventative antibiotic tablets at preventing recurrent UTIs in premenopausal women who were prone to UTI recurrence. Although the study showed that antibiotic treatments were more effective, it also found that antibiotic resistance became more prevalent in women taking them, besides disturbing the vaginal normal flora. Already after one month 90% of the women became resistant against the antibiotic. These women also developed resistance against other antibiotics. Beerepoot reports that this is significant disadvantage. In the cranberry group there was no increase in resistance.
